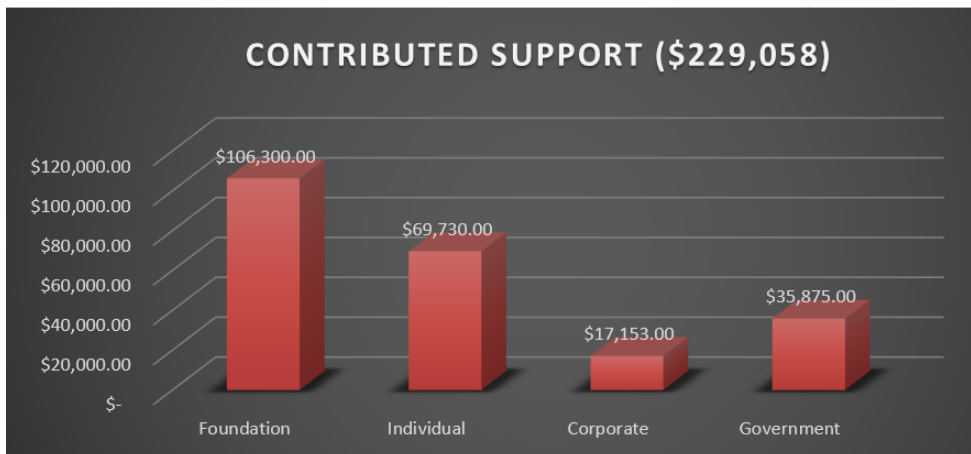


FINANCIAL OVERVIEW (May 1, 2021—April 30, 2022)

Immigrant City Archives, Inc., dba Lawrence History Center, is a private, not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) charitable organization. Our approved annual **operating budget for fy2022 was \$205,250** with an additional \$40,000+/- in capital expenses for historic preservation of and accessibility to our facilities. **Our Revenues and Other Support** as of 4/30/2022 were **\$339,550 (Contributed Support: \$229,058; Earned and Other Revenue: \$27,861)**, including \$82,631 with donor restrictions (*in-kind donations*). **Total expenses were \$348,682.**

Reviewed Financial Statements for the Years Ending April 30, 2022 and 2021 were prepared by *Kenneth J. Plumb, Jr., C.P.A.*, Plumb and Pierce. It was his conclusion that, based on the review, he is not aware of any material modifications that should be made to the financial statements in order for them to be in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

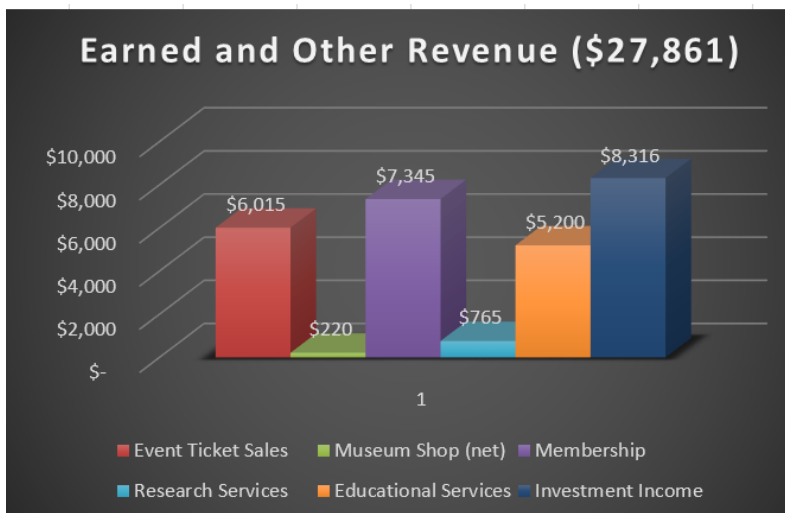

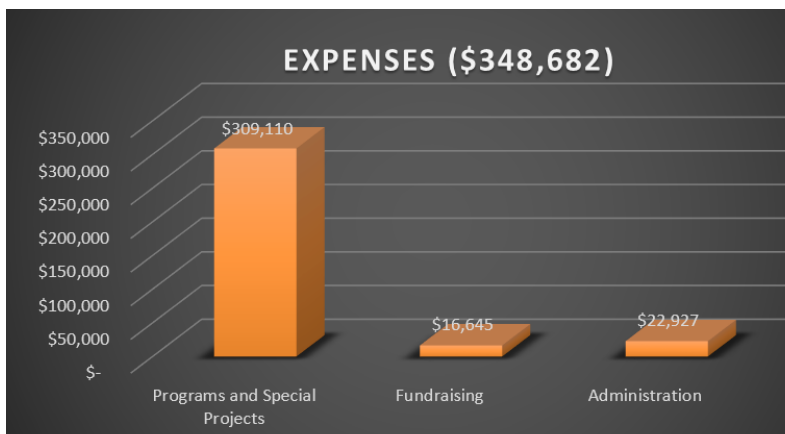
